**ADAMS MORGAN PARTNERSHIP BUSINESS
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (AMPBID) RESOLUTION IN
SUPPORT OF RENEWAL**

WHEREAS, the cleanliness and safety of Adams Morgan is crucial to the overall well-being of the business owners, staff, residents and visitors to the neighborhood;

WHEREAS, continuing to attract and retain commercial tenants will make a positive impact to the vibrancy and destination appeal of Adams Morgan;

WHEREAS, continuing to activate public space with events that promote the neighborhood and beautification activities will enhance the foot traffic to the business corridor and bring additional business and tax revenue;

WHEREAS, the net fiscal impact of the Adams Morgan commercial corridor toward the DC Government's overall fiscal health is measurable, significant and positive;

WHEREAS, the fiscal contributions of the Adams Morgan commercial corridor to the DC Government are attributable in part from the efforts of the AMPBID;

WHEREAS, the continuation of the positive impacts outlined above require the focus of an organization dedicated to that mission – the AMPBID – who is charged with the day-to-day cleanliness, safety and marketing of the neighborhood.
