NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Extension Of The Term Of The Adams Morgan Partnership Business Improvement District

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to section 18 of the Business Improvement Districts Act of 1996, D.C. Official Code § 2-1215.18, the Department of Small and Local Business Development on behalf of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development will hold a public hearing to determine whether to approve the request by the Adams Morgan Partnership Business Improvement District (BID) to extend the term of the BID for another 5 years. The current term of the Adams Morgan Partnership BID will expire September 30, 2011. If the request for extension is granted, the new term will expire on September 30, 2015.

The hearing will be held at 5:00 p.m. on **Wednesday, August 31, 2011** in Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC.

This public hearing is being conducted to inform citizens about the application to extend the term of the Adams Morgan Partnership Business Improvement District and to ensure that interested parties have an opportunity to present their views on the application in a public forum. **Complete copies of the application will be available, effective Monday, August 22, 2011**, for public review between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Department of Small and Local Business Development (at Judiciary Square), 441 4th Street, NW, Suite 970N, Washington, DC. The recertification package will also be available at the Adams Morgan Partnership BID office between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm, effective August 22, 2011. The Adams Morgan Partnership BID office is located at 1804 Belmont Street, NW, Washington, DC.

Individuals presenting testimony are requested to bring ten copies of their testimony to the hearing. Individuals will be limited to 5 minutes of oral testimony and organizations will be limited to 10 minutes of oral testimony.
